



314. Saturday 3.

Glorious day, at 10 am we set sail. Six transports, with an escont of 7 destroyers + cruisers, 2 materplanes + an observation balloon, attached to a courses, which returned later in the day. During the afternoon an accident happened the chief gunner was inspecting a gun which was apparently out of order. whilst he was in front of the muzzle the gun went off blowing him to pieces, only his legs being left on board. Towards evening sea became rough hearly enembedy sick. Glad to get in my hammock which is the best place to get when feeling sick. Rother a qued sensation, all the hammoch swaring to spo. Slept O.K.

19th august.

316. Sunday 4 my first Sunday at Sea. most glorious day. Sea calm. Feeling AI after previous days rough sea, just after the usual boat parade, we had a little excilerent Low submarines suddenly made their appearance, but disappeared as quickly. Low destroyers with marvellous quick res fired at them, & gave chase about a mile away one submarine came to the surface was immediately fired at a sank, the other was chased off. Soon afterwards we met 5 merchant vessels coming from america to England. with cargo. Without doubt there subs. were waiting for them. 


